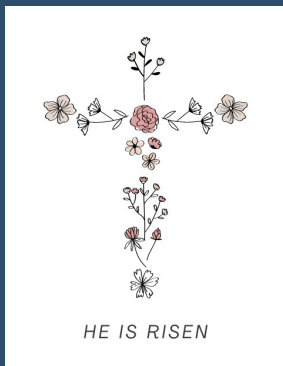

WHAT MAKES CHRISTIANITY DIFFERENT?

Something distinguishes Christianity from all the religions of the world.
